

APPLICATION TO WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP FOR WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATION TOWER(S) AND/OR ANTENNA(S)

Attached to this Application is a copy of Article 26 of the Whitehall Township Zoning Ordinance, entitled "Wireless Telecommunication Towers and Antennas". Applicants: Please retain your copy of Article 26. Do not return it with your completed application. Article 26 applies to all "new antennas and towers", except for towers under 50 feet in height owned and operated by federally licensed amateur radio station operators or which are used exclusively for receive only antennas. Also, special exceptions apply for AM array towers.

Pre-existing towers and pre-existing antennas are allowed to continue their present usage. Routine maintenance, including replacement with a new tower of like construction and height, is authorized without submitting this application. Also, rebuilding of damaged or destroyed pre-existing towers or antennas is authorized without submitting this application, if the tower or antenna is replaced within **180** days from the date of damage or destruction.

Placing a new antenna on an existing tower or structure, or expanding a tower, is not authorized without filing this application.

If the tower or antenna is proposed to be located: (a) in the "Tower Permitted District, then if the proposed tower complies with the Ordinance the Township Zoning Administrator may issue a permit without any hearing; (b) in the "Tower Special Use District", then only the Planning Commission, after a hearing, may issue a permit.

This questionnaire must be completed by anyone required by Article 26 to obtain a permit from Whitehall Township for a tower or antenna. In response to each question, circle "Yes" or "No". For each "No" answer, attach a separate sheet explaining the circumstances.

Attach to the complete application, a statement from a civil, mechanical, or electrical engineer: (a) certifying that such person is a licensed professional civil, mechanical, or electrical engineer; (b) that such engineer has reviewed the entire application and the plans of the tower(s) and/or antenna(s) subject to this application; (c) that such tower(s) and/or antenna(s) (as applicable) will be structurally sound, will comply with all applicable FCC regulations (including to radio frequency/radiation emissions regulations) and with all

applicable building and other construction code requirements.

- A. The sum of \$500 if the proposed tower(s) and/or antenna(s) is located in the Township's "Tower Special Use District".
- B. The sum of \$250 if in "Tower Permitted District".
- C. The sum of \$250 to extend or add to existing facility.
