NOTICE is hereby given that any qualified elector of the County of Muskegon who is not already registered, may register to vote in the **MICHIGAN PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD TUESDAY, AUGUST 2, 2022** at the office of the City or Township Clerk; office of the Secretary of State or at the office of a designated State Agency during their regular business hours. Registration forms can be obtained at www.mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township or City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, July 18, 2022**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the following:
