- F. Office- busy day with residents looking to Early Vote. 71% of absentee ballots back.


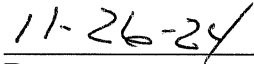
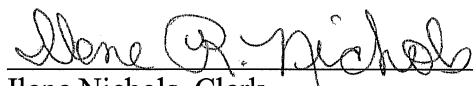
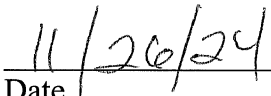
XIV. Public Comment
